10th International Convention of SPIC MACAY inaugurated at IIT Hyderabad. Hon'ble Governor of Telangana presided over the inaugural ceremony of a week-long cultural immersion

Hyderabad, May 26: The 10th International Convention of **SPIC MACAY** (Society for the Promotion of Indian Classical Music and Culture Amongst Youth) was formally inaugurated on the evening of May 26, 2025, at the Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad by the Hon'ble Governor of Telangana, *Shri Jishnu Dev Varma*. His presence lent dignity and solemnity to the occasion, marking the official commencement of a week-long exploration into India's classical and spiritual traditions.

More than 1,500 students & volunteers from across India and overseas have gathered at IITH for this immersive experience. The day began with early morning personal time and a holistic breakfast, setting the tone for a balanced and mindful routine.

In the forenoon, participants watched "*Gandhi*", the Oscar-winning biopic directed by Sir Richard Attenborough. The screening was followed by a discussion led by **Dr. Kiran Seth**, Founder of SPIC MACAY, who reflected on the film's philosophical depth and its portrayal of Gandhian ideals such as simplicity, discipline, and inner strength.

The orientation session held post-lunch was addressed by *Dr. Kiran Seth*, who urged students to treat the convention as an inner journey—akin to a stay in an *ashram*—marked by simplicity, discipline, and reflection. Subsequently, an orientation for the faculty coordinators was conducted, where their vital role in guiding and nurturing the students throughout the week was highlighted.

At 4:00 pm, a *Nadaswaram* recital by **Padma Shri Vidwan Sheikh Mahboob Subhani and Vidwan Kaleeshabi Mahaboob** filled the air with auspicious sounds. The performance, rooted in temple tradition, prepared the atmosphere for the formal inauguration that followed.

The Inaugural Ceremony at 6:00 pm, in the august presence of Hon'ble Governor Shri Jishnu Dev Varma, was the highlight of the day. Dignitaries from IIT Hyderabad, artists, scholars, and volunteers were present. The Governor, in his address, appreciated the work of SPIC MACAY in nurturing India's intangible heritage among the youth and called upon students to carry this awareness forward in their lives.

Following the formal inauguration, **Padma Bhushan awardees** *Shri Raja and Smt. Radha Reddy* presented an evocative *Kuchipudi* recital. Their performance, featuring excerpts from "*Bhama Kalapam*" and other classical compositions, displayed grace, expressive clarity, and devotion.

The evening concluded with a Hindustani violin concert by **Padma Bhushan** *Dr. N. Rajam*. Her *gayaki ang* style brought out the emotive essence of the ragas, offering a tranquil end to the first day's proceedings.

A Glimpse into the Days Ahead (May 27–31):

Each day will begin at 3:30 am with *Brahma Muhurta* sessions in Hatha Yoga, *Nada Yoga*, and meditation, guided by spiritual mentors including *Ustad F. Wasifuddin Dagar*, *Swami Tyagarajananda*, *Zarna Mohan*, *Brahma Kumaris*, *Guru Ghanakanta Bora*, *and Vidushi Manda Sudharani*.

A key component of the convention is the **Intensive Workshops**, with **28 concurrent sessions in classical music, dance, crafts, and traditional arts** led by renowned gurus. These allow for direct transmission of knowledge in the *guru-shishya* tradition.

Afternoons will feature screenings of spiritual and classical cinema, talks by eminent personalities, and presentations of folk and traditional theatre. The evenings will culminate in concerts by eminent classical artists.

On May 31, 2025:

The concluding day will witness student performances based on their intensive learnings, followed by a nightlong *Raatri Baithak* featuring Vidwan G.J.R. Krishnan, Vidushi Lalgudi Vijayalakshmi, Pandit Ulhas Kashalkar, Pandit Suresh Talwalkar, Ustad Bahauddin Dagar, Vidushi Kapila Venu, and Ustad F. Wasifuddin Dagar.
