Hyderabad, 13th March 2025: The Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad (IITH) has been ranked among the world's top universities in six subjects in the latest edition of the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2025 (https://www.topuniversities.com/subject-rankings).

This prestigious ranking is a testament to IITH's academic excellence and research impact. The QS rankings evaluated over 18,300 university programs across 1,700 institutions in 100 locations worldwide, making this recognition a significant achievement for the institute.

IITH has been ranked in six subjects, with three appearing in the rankings for the first time:

- Materials Science (*New entry*) (401-550)
- Electrical & Electronic Engineering (New entry) (501-550)
- Chemistry (*New entry*) (601-700)
- Mechanical, Aeronautical & Manufacturing Engineering (501-575)
- Physics & Astronomy (501-550)
- Computer Science & Information Systems (701-750)

In the broad subject area "Engineering & Technology" we secured a ranking between 501 and 550 for the first time, securing 1st rank among second generation IITs and 8th rank among all IITs.

The QS world university rankings 2025 released in June 2024 confirmed that IITH continues to secure its position among the Top 10 technical institutes in the country.
